

Club Day Sign-Up Instructions

County Club Days

Sign-ups for both County and Regional Club Days have moved to an online format. Links to online registrations are sent to all Greenwood County 4-H Families by the Extension Office. Club leaders will coordinate any group sign-ups including but not limited to club skits, gavel games, and model meetings. Those will be set before individual project links go out so that families know when to schedule their other events. Sign-ups are on a first come first serve basis and no spots will be held unless there are prior arrangements made with the office in special circumstances.

Once the sign-up date has passed, the office will send out the schedule for all events to all families. As a club leader, it is your responsibility to help keep your club members informed throughout this entire process.

Regional Club Days

After county club days, those groups and individuals that received Champion (Top Blue) are to let the Extension Office know who will be advancing to compete at Regionals. Similar to County Club Days, registration has gone to an online format. Registration links will be dispersed by the Office to Club Leaders and families that have indicated that their children wish to advance. These are on a first come, first serve basis for all families within the counties that compete at our Regional Club Days. No spots will be held or guaranteed until the parent or club leader submits their registration.

Once the sign-up date has passed, the office will send out the schedule for all events to all families. As a club leader, it is your responsibility to help keep your club members informed throughout this entire process.
