Agronomy and Horticulture are now under building exhibits

- Shooting Sports is in its own department

Building Block Engineering

- “Exhibit made from kit” is now only ages 7-10 – county only

Educational Project Exhibits

- Make sure to include references used to create exhibit

Foods

- Lowered one ribbon placing if not on disposable plate or cake board and in a plastic bag. Large bags are available at the extension office (\$0.25)
- Preservation – use matching jar and lid brands

Food Gift Package

- Do not cellophane wrap baskets
- Include Sugar Percentage worksheet if basket contains frosting or glaze

Photography

- Removed Digital Composite Class
- Mounting instructions available through QR code – will have a mounting day in June

Shopping in Style

- Only Juniors can make posters
- Intermediates and Seniors have to use a tri-fold

Visual Arts

- Descriptions are now listed in the fair book of each class

Woodworking

- Only one class now per age division
- Projects entered under “Any Woodworking Project”
- “Refinished/Repaired” is still a county-only project

Updated rule: participants must wear a nice shirt or a current Greenwood County Fair t-shirt to show or sell livestock
