- We will not hold any spot for a vendor. It is your responsibility to be at the Fairgrounds in ample time to secure a location to set up your trailer. We strongly suggest coming the Saturday before the show to guarantee a spot near the show rings.
- Barns will be open for exhibitors who wish to bring animals the night before.
- Trailer parking is ONLY available to the North of the Fairgrounds and North of Midwest Mill Buildings. The entry is off of Jefferson Street.
